Women's Suffrage in Chester County, Thursday, March 27th, 6:30PM
In honor of Women's History Month, Robyn Young will speak about women suffragists in Chester County and their impact in Pennsylvania from 1840-1920. The program will include the 1852 Women's Rights Convention in West Chester, Dr. Ann Preston of West Grove, and Evan Pugh of Oxford. Pugh was an ally of women's right to vote and was considered a "suffragent." The presentation will include the history of Bala Farm in East Bradford Township and how it was used as a training center for the Women's Land Army during World War I. Young's new book, "*Women's Suffrage in Pennsylvania - 1840-1920*" will be available for sale after the program.
